On Saturday, March 31, The Alzheimer's Association hosted their 13th Annual Forget-Me-Not Gala, at the Holiday Inn & Conference Center at the Francis Scott Key Mall in Frederick.

He decided to start raising money for a cause that he felt was quite worthy as his grandmother was affected by Alzheimers at the time. ## Confessions of a Drugstore Car Guy

The other day a number of club members drove to Berkeley Springs, WV for the HMCCC Spring Cruise. Paul and Linda Schneider made the trip but drove Linda's SUV because Paul's '55 doesn't have windshield wipers. Eighty-two years ago a couple of Paul's relatives and a relative of Linda's made a trip through the same area (and a lot more) in a Model T Ford.

### Eight Hundred Miles in a Ford

Washington, D.C. – Sunday, Aug. 8, 1920, 8:10 am. Dr. Winfield S. "Winnie" Whitman, 39, Dr. Samuel O. "Burdie" Burdette, 28, and Mr. O. C. "Tom" Sabin, 46, left 932 New York Ave., NW for a trip to Chicago in a Ford Model T sedan. The men looked forward to a journey which promised to be quite an adventure.

They filled-up with gas and oil at the corner of 16<sup>th</sup> and M Streets, NW, planning to drive 130 miles that day and reach Chicago by Wednesday evening, August 11<sup>th</sup>. After 28 miles, near Middlebrook, MD, the trip choked to a halt due to dirt in the fuel lines. It was quickly cleaned out and only 10 minutes were lost.

They reached Damascus, MD a little after 10 and ten minutes later stopped so Burdie could say "hi" to his cousin at the Ridgeville Garage. By 11:15, despite slow going due to roadwork, they reached Frederick, MD and mailed some postcards home.

Just past Frederick they came upon an auto which had overturned rounding a curve. The driver had apparently braked too hard and caused the car to skid out of control before overturning. A female passenger had a broken collarbone and was pretty bruised up while another appeared to be in shock. The three men in the car seemed to be unhurt and our party was thankful Winnie had had the brakes attended to prior the leaving Washington.

The expedition stopped for a chicken dinner (\$2.45) in Hagerstown, MD, and picked-up a man whose car had broken down and needed to get to Cumberland, MD to meet his father. The man said there wasn't a train so he was willing to pay "almost anything" and/or ride on the running board to get to his destination.

Beyond Hagerstown the trip devolved into three or four miles uphill at low speed followed by the same distance down the other fighting to keep from going over the side. With the radiator boiling by the top of each "mountain" and the brakes smoking going down the other side, the men had a hard time enjoying the beautiful scenery.

They passed several wrecks and said that all the cars coming downhill were experiencing smoking brakes. At the top of each mountain, helpful "natives" had barrels of "Water for Sale" but Burdie carried his own in oil cans he brought along. While descending one of the mountains they met another "Lizzie" (Model T) carrying a load of chickens on the way up.

Just before tackling the third mountain, at 5:10, the engine "commenced to knock a little" because it was leaking oil. They stopped for a few minutes but don't report finding or fixing anything. They did, however, have oil aboard so they could replenish whatever was lost.

Things soon went from bad to worse. Although Tom had to tighten the brake bands in each valley, they quit working altogether at the top of Polish Mountain. Tom, who was driving, was unable to stop until he ran into a pile of crushed rock on the roadside and they found themselves overlooking a beautiful valley with the car straddling the pile of stone.

They fixed the brakes for the n<sup>th</sup> time but their passenger had had enough. He paid \$2 for the trip to this point and apparently made some other arrangements for the balance of his journey.

The men and their Ford reached Cumberland, MD about 7:00 pm, where, although they reported being very hungry and tired, they were also in a big hurry. They ate and filled up with gas, oil and water and, at 7:30, continued on their journey; but not before nearly getting "run in" for parking in the wrong place.

They only made eleven miles, however, before they had to "reline" all of their transmission bands. They found they could hardly climb even the slightest incline at very low speed. At Frostburg, MD, (it was 9:20 pm by then and probably dark or nearly so) they found a place where they could get the supplies (new linings) and tools to make the necessary repairs. It was 11:00 pm by the time they'd gotten the supplies, a Coca Cola and found a spot at the edge of town where they could do the job.

The dirty work fell to Tom with Winnie's assistance. How they did the job in the dark they don't say, but they got the job done by 2:30 am, Monday, August 9<sup>th</sup>. Since it was so late, or early, they decided to keep going to Uniontown, PA.

After climbing up and sliding down two more mountains they had an easy time of it until just after day break when one of the front tires blew out. That woke Burdie who continued looking for what made the "bang" while his buddies fixed the tire.

Along this stretch of road, signs advertising an upcoming camp meeting admonished travelers to "Prepare to meet thy God" and asked "Where will you spend eternity" and "Have you made your peace with God?" Some industrious preacher obviously understood what drivers in these mountains were thinking!

The roads so far had been well kept if a tad too up and down. They arrived in Uniontown, PA at 7:30 that morning. While looking for a place to get cleaned up and get something to eat they also found out they could still get anything they wanted in the way of liquor even though prohibition had been effect since January, 1920.


