



Spring Cruise 2015 Saturday, May 2 to the Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center—part of the National Air & Space Museum near Dulles Airport

We will be leaving the Mount Airy Burger King at **9:30 am on Saturday, May 2** (Come early if you wish to eat before we go – please be “gassed up” and ready to roll at **9:30 on the dot!**), and we’ll cruise out Route 70 to Route 340/15. We will meet the Frederick Bunch at the Mount Zion exit on Route 340/15 South. The Mount Zion exit is easy-off, easy-on, so you can exit and wait safely on the ramp.

The Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center is part of the National Air & Space Museum located at 14390 Air and Space Museum Parkway in Chantilly, VA near Dulles Airport. It is a free museum telling the history of human flight with exhibits of many actual aircraft and spacecraft. Admission is free, but there is a \$15 per vehicle parking fee.

We plan to stop at Red Robin for lunch before getting to the museum.
